Growing and Care Instructions

Planting Instructions

- Carefully unwrap your Glass Terrarium and place on a solid surface. Place the terrarium where it will receive natural sunlight or indirect light.
- Place your germination disk inside the Glass Terrarium and add one cup of water.
 The germination disk will absorb the water and expand into your growing medium.
- Break up cylinder of moist soil and smooth into bottom of bowl.
- Gently push down the growing medium so it sits firmly on base of the Glass Terrarium and does not extend out of the opening. The growing medium should be well moistened but there should not be any pockets of standing water.
- Plan your garden, sprinkle half the seeds onto your growing medium as desired.
 Gently push them into the medium. Cover the medium with sand and mist the top gently. The seeds will sprout in about one to two weeks. This kit comes with enough seeds for two plantings. Be sure to save half the seeds if you want another planting and store your saved seeds at room temperature in an area without too much humidity.

Growing Tips

- Water as needed, the growing medium should be moist and have no pockets of standing water.
- You may need to add water 2 to 3 times per week depending on conditions.
- Allow your Glass Terrarium to receive sunlight or bright indirect light for several hours each day.

Sabal Palm

Sabal Palm is named the tree of Victory because it always grows and lives in the best climates. Sabal Palm is a very common type of palm seen in California and Florida. They can grow up to 70 feet tall and live for hundreds of years. Palms, although they can be found almost everywhere in the world have become less widespread over time and were once thought to be one of the most invasive types of plant on the earth.



Cabbage Palm

Perhaps the most recognized version of Palm, cabbage palm has many different names and is one of 15 different species of Palmetto Palm. Cabbage Palm has grown in popularity because it is one of the most durable palms and can tolerate a wide variety of soil types. Cabbage palm can grow up to 80 feet tall and can tolerate freezing cold and hot weather. This palm will grow quickly and easily thus an ideal choice for your terrarium!
